

He believed in a young filmmaker and I believed him when he had his Boulevard Films troubles. We stuck by each other over the years, in thick and thin.




6pm - Kiss of Death

Directed by Terry McMahon - Irish/African - 90min

MUFF alumni Terry McMahon is back with his fourth feature, Kiss of Death. We have played and awarded his previous three features and we are honoured to play his new one on Opening Night. This time Terry is off to Africa for a dark morality lesson.

Naïve, idealistic, and passionate; Tony, a young teacher, is sent to teach in Northern Nigeria, where he believes he can transcend all differences through his commitment to the children and the job. But, when a girl collapses in his class and there are no female teachers to help the girl, Tony has no idea that his life-saving intervention might cost him his own life. McMahon explores his familiar themes of class, religious tension and clash of civilisations in this new work, with themes of darkness and ignorance that lead to tragedy. McMahon's fourth feature is a luminescent meditation on the Heart of Darkness, beautifully and transcendentally photographed and with a big heart. A highlight of MUFF 2024.



8pm - Vincent

Directed and starring Alan King - AUS - 90min

Troubled writer Vincent Tremblay, escapes to an isolated retreat, determined to complete his first novel. However, his solitude is short lived as a powerful force suddenly manifests itself and Vincent finds himself caught firmly in its grasp. Vincent is a challenging black comedy, with fatalistic

and fantastic touches that's interpretation is open to the viewer. A daring new Australian film, showcasing the diverse talents of Alan King as star, writer and director. You'll know Alan's work from past MUFF films, for e.g. the cinema of Tim Burns. The somewhat experimental, non-linear narrative that refers quite a bit to the Godard & the Nouvelle Vague, the conceptual ambiguity that he handles, makes this semiotic directorial debut film by Australian Alan King one of its high points of MUFF 24. Without a doubt, it makes its director and star a filmmaker to follow. It's won awards in Germany and Chile and plays MUFF in 2024.

8pm - What is a Woman?

Dir Matt Walsh - USA - 90 mns - doco

A powerful documentary by Matt Walsh that challenges transgender ideology by asking a fundamental question: what does it mean to be a woman? Viewed from a Gender Critical perspective, the film argues that redefining "woman" as a subjective identity rather than a biological reality, erases women as a distinct sex class, with far-reaching consequences. Through inter-

views with doctors, activists, and others, Walsh exposes how this shift not only threatens the rights, protections, and unique experiences of women and girls but also destabilises foundational societal structures. What is a Woman? calls for a return to biological definitions, contending that only by honouring the truth of two sexes can society preserve the integrity of womanhood and safeguard its social fabric.










TRIBUTE TO FRANK HOWSON

ture. Frank meant this film as his epitaph, and with him gone, it is indeed that. Starring a stellar cast including Martin Landau, Steven Berkhoff John Savage, Michael J. Pollard, Bert Newton, John Micael Howson, Tommy Dysart, Molly Meldrum, John Flaus, Kristen Condon and many others including MUFF festival director Richard Wolstencroft, this is the perfect Frank Tribute and send off movie for Our Frank, frankly. I asked my old mucker David Thrussell from SNOG and No Goat Show fame to pick three essential Conspiracy movie masterpieces for MUFF 24 here they are - RW


WINTER KILLS (1979) - US - 90min. 4.30pm Tuesday December 10th


Essentially unknown, this taught, surreal conspiracy thriller is one of the greatest 'political' films to ever come out of Hollyweird. Jeff Bridges plays the brother of a slain US President (AKA JFK) who falls down the 'rabbit hole' investigating the murder while under the shadow of his oligarch father, played by John Huston, (AKA Kennedy family patriarch Joseph Kennedy). Adapted from the book by Richard Condon ('The Manchurian Candidate', 'Seven Days In May'), with Anthony Perkins as J. Edgar Hoover (!) and a bizarre cameo from Elizabeth Taylor (!!), this dark, unlikely satire has more twists than a maze on Epstein Island.

FLASHPOINT (1984) - US - 90min. **4.30pm Wednesday December 11th** An intriguing yet forgotten film that stars Kris Kristofferson as a disgruntled Texas border guard, who stumbles upon the dark secrets of a deep US political conspiracy. Scored by Tangerine Dream and unfairly neglected, this well-crafted yet cynical film (think 'JFK' meets 'The X-Files') deserves serious reappraisal.

THE FORMULA (1980) - US - 90min. **6pm Thursday December 12th** Starring George C. Scott, Marlon Brando and Sir John Gielgud, 'The Formula' revolves around a murderous international conspiracy to keep resources 'scarce' and thus energy (and oil) prices unnaturally high (it could never happen!). Shot mostly on location in a rainy and grim Germany and featuring cunning Nazis and perfidious Big Oil operatives, 'The Formula' has slow burn tension and real world relevance.

ASSAULT ON SACRED MOUNTAIN - Dir: Frank Booth - AUS - 80min 8pm Monday December 9th

Five foreigners, led by local tour guide Joey, set out for an overnight hiking trip in the rugged mountains on Taiwan's east coast. Not long into their journey, they are ordered to turn back by three soldiers in army uniforms, who tell Joey that the trail ahead is closed for military training.

The hikers face a dilemma: do they retreat and let the invaders complete their mission - and risk a war - or take a stand and try to stop them. If the enemy succeeds in their mission, critical infrastructure in Taiwan will be taken down, dealing a devastating blow to the hi-tech economy of the US and its allies. The stakes couldn't be higher.

VAMPIRE ZOMBIES... FROM SPACE! - Dir: Michael Stasko - CA - 90min 9.30pm Monday December 9th

From the depths of space, Dracula has devised his most dastardly plan yet; turning the residents of a small American town into his personal army of vampire zombies! A motley crew consisting of a grizzled detective, a skeptical rookie cop, a chain-smoking greaser, and a determined young woman band together to save the world from — (see title). Packed with gruesome special eects, b-movie miniatures, and gut-busting laughs, "Vampire Zombies...from Space!" is a bloody comedy that has its foundation in horror films of the 1950s.

L.A. 40RCE - Dir: Giovanni Zelko - USA - 120min 8pm Tuesday December 10th

Two veteran Los Angeles homicide detectives track down a gang of arms dealers responsible for a quintuple murder that has captivated the country, amid an historic crime wave in Los Angeles.

Followed by talk by International Guest, Director Giovanni Zelko

TRAUMNOVELLE - Dir: Florian Frerichs - GERMANY - 110min 10pm Tuesday December 10th

A colourful adaptation of Schnitzler's work, in which a woman tells her husband that she has fantasies with other people, triggering his desire for his own adventures. Set in modern kinky Berlin, the film is much more than a mere reboot of Kubrick's "Eyes Wide Shut".

CHAINSAWS WERE SINGING - Dir: Sander Maran - ESTONIA - 120min 2.30pm Thursday December 12th

Adventures await when new lovers get separated by a chainsaw killer. An absolutely bonkers R-rated action-horror-musical-comedy epic.
